B.C. Student Loan Process

On-line applications are processed quicker than paper applications.
If your loan is approved, the following process will occur.

1. Master Loan Agreement

- a. Master Loan Agreement is mailed to you
- b. Read document thoroughly
- c. With 2 pieces of ID and your banking information, bring Master Agreement to Canada Post Office
- d. Sign agreement in front of Postal Agent
- e. Postal Agent will send agreement to B.C. Student Loan Service Centre

2. Notification of Assessment

- a. Notification of Assessment will be available on-line
- b. The amount of your loan and disbursement dates will be explained in your assessment

3. Tuition Deferral

- a. Bring your assessment to the NWCC Financial Aid Officer and request for a deferral
- b. You may be able to make arrangements to pay your tuition fees once you receive the student loan

4. Confirmation of Enrollment

- a. School confirms your enrollment at the college, a few of days before school starts

5. B.C. Student Loan

- a. Once the confirmation of enrolment has been processed, B.C. Student Loan Service Bureau will deposit loan in your bank account, usually within one to two weeks **AFTER** classes start
